infested with lizards that carried venom. This led to high fever and death. Moses had been a desert dweller for many years and knew that the bites were not always fatal. Panic caused the poison to spread. If the people would relax the fever and its cause would pass. So Moses had to find a way to calm his people. God inspired him to create a statue of the serpent as a sign that the almighty could control real lizards. Jesus may be using this illustration to show the psychological power of the crucifixion. His death on the cross was a reminder of God's ultimate power over sin and evil.




