

Old Yeast

Ancient people depended on natural yeast to give bread its light consistency. Yeast is a microscopic plant that is in the air all around us. It will take root in a mixture of flour



and water. This is commonly known as "sour dough". Since it can take several days to mature, bread-makers would save a small amount as a starter batch. This speeded up the yeast-making process. Eventually the starter batch might become corrupt. Jewish women would throw out all yeast in the spring. Until new yeast could be grown they would eat unleavened (or yeast less) bread.



"EXULTET"

The Exultet is a liturgical hymn of the Catholic Church that is sung on Easter night at the solemn Easter Vigil by a deacon or cantor. It proclaims the victory of light over darkness, symbolized by the paschal candle that is lit, and announces the resurrection of Christ and invites the whole assembly to rejoice at the



fulfilment of the prophecy of the Paschal Mystery. It is also called praeconium paschale or laus cerei. The Exultet was written on a long scroll of parchment that the deacon-cantor slid down from the pulpit as he narrated its contents.


