



Then they left the final choice to God by either rolling dice or drawing straws. They felt that God would influence the outcome of this final choice. After the Gospel the Paschal Candle, lit from the New Fire of the Easter Vigil, is extinguished to symbolize the departure of Christ. Christ returns to heaven taking His manhood with Him, and to prepare a place for all His faithful people. Each time we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension, we remember that the Catholic Church is a Missionary Church. We are called by Jesus to go out to the whole world and proclaim the Gospel message.


