

The birth of our Blessed Lord brings with it great joy that scatters the sadness of suffering. It is the birthday of Life, the Life which annihilates the fear of death and engenders joy, promising everlasting life. Mother Mary shares this joy as we see her embarking on a perilous journey to visit her cousin St. Elizabeth. This visitation is more than a happy exchange of support between two women sharing the joys of childbearing. It is a story of faith as well as friendship and of sacrificial love. The unborn Christ child received in this home a warm welcome as opposed to the cold welcome He receives in Bethlehem when there is no room for Him in the Inn.

At Christmas everybody is welcomed; nobody is excluded from this happiness. The same cause for joy is common to all, for as our Savior found nobody free from guilt when He came to bring an end to sin and death, so, He came with redemption for all. We are emboldened, for He has called us to life. For we were bought at the price of Christ's blood, and were rescued from the power of darkness; we are called to live in the Light of His Life.

Like Mother Mary, we are all invited in our own lives to do the will of God, by allowing Christ to be born into our hearts. So that the Gifts of the Holy Spirit may become a part of our lives and we make Christmas a pattern to be followed in everyday living. Moreover, we become that perfect Christmas Gift by saying to God as Mary exclaimed, 'Let it be done to me according to Your Will.' Wishing you and your family a very Merry Christmas, May the birth of Christ reign in our lives so He may fill us with His lasting Peace.
