As one born abnormally

Saint Paul gives some historical information as he testifies to the legitimacy of his doctrine. He mentions several postresurrection appearances of Jesus--including some not otherwise mentioned in the Gospels. He ends with a reminiscence of his own vision of



the Risen Lord. Because Jesus had ascended into heaven some time before, Paul felt that his experience made him like a child born after the normal time. Paul had encountered Jesus while traveling to Damascus, Syria. His mission had been to arrest and executes Christians. Suddenly a bright light and powerful voice literally struck Paul. This experience would heavily influence Paul's teachings, especially that of the spiritual relation between Jesus and all of his followers. (Fr. Lonsdale Commentaries & Clip-Art)
