

The last Adam

Paul has been dealing with a local issue in Corinth. There is a group that has denied the need for a physical resurrection. They are influenced by Greek philosophy, which believes that anything material is of no value. To illustrate his belief that the body is



important, he makes a connection between the first human being and Jesus. Adam was created from the dust of the earth. In fact, the word "adam" means "dust". Paul notes that though Jesus came from heaven, he became human--the new Adam. We have all descended from the first human, but now we begin to share divine life through the ultimate human: Jesus, the son of God.

Ash Wednesday March 5th

Ash Wednesday begins the forty days of Lent. We practice prayer, fasting and sacrifice on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, we fast



and abstain from meat. Catholics who are 18-58 years old are required to keep a limited fast. A single normal meal and two snacks. Catholics 14 years and older are required to abstain from eating meat. Mass with the imposition of ashes will be celebrated @ 12:00 noon and @ 7 pm immediately following the Wednesday Devotion Novena.

Gather your Palms

Traditionally, ashes used on Ash Wednesday are palms that have been collected from the previous year's Palm Sunday; they are burned down into a fine powder and mixed with holy water or chrism oil to create a light paste; or sometimes they are left dry and are sprinkled on the head rather than made into a paste. If you have palms at home from previous Palm Sundays, you can bring them back to church and they will be burned, and used this year on Ash Wednesday.


