Solemnity of Saints Peter & Paul Apostles June 29th. The apostles share the same feast day even though they suffered on different days. Simon, son of Jonah and Andrea's brother, first among the disciples prophesied that Jesus was the Christ, the son of the living God, from which he was called Peter. Paul, the Apostle of the Gentiles preached to the Jews



and Greeks, Christ crucified. Both in faith and love of Jesus Christ announced the Gospel and died martyrs under Emperor Nero in Rome: the first, according to the tradition, crucified upside down and buried in the Vatican, the latter pierced with sword and buried on the via Ostiense. On this day Catholics all over the world honor and celebrate their triumph. Let us embrace what they believed, their life, their labors, their sufferings, their preaching, and their confession of faith."
